Bible studies-Lent


Fr. Lou will continue his Facebook morning prayer on Thursday mornings at 8:30am. About 10-15 people attend per week.

Hi Barbara and Friends from St. Mary's Church,

Thank you so much for the wonderful Valentine gift bags for women in Shelters. It was my honor to distribute the 21 colorful bags to several locations. I traveled to the Saratoga Domestic Violence Shelter in Malta, NY to give 8 of the wonderful bags to their shelter residence. I met the shelter assistant director who could not believe how many needed items you were donating. She was so happy to get them to residents and remarked that they were so thoughtful to include individual Valentine cards with a Bible verse on each. Het her know that they had been blessed.

Next, I drove to Catskill, NY to distribute the remaining bags to women who are residents of Riverside Rehab Facility. Through research, my group has found that many times women recovering from alcohol and drug abuse are victims of domestic violence, either in their upbringing or in their marriages. Statistically, it is 1 in 4 women who are affected by domestic violence. The women at Riverside were so pleased to be remembered on a day that is devoted to love, and yet they often don't think of themselves as being lovable. They were so happy to see so many thoughtful items in a red bag!
